

#### CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE

#### Dear Readers,

Thanks to our Advisors, Trustees, volunteers and donors, the Foundation, founded in Nov 2009, is continuing to make steady progress and is gaining recognition in the community. Last year has been particularly successful. We have raised a total of \$850,000 and given out some \$500,000. We now cover 11 beneficiary schools, including one secondary school and 10 primary schools, with student population approaching 10,000.

- Free EyeGlass Service for Needy Students
- Various Scholarship Award Schemes for Primary Schools

Guided by the ideals of the late Rev. Brother Paul Sun, the Board of Trustees is following a policy of extending the coverage of the Foundation's work. Meanwhile, three more primary schools will be joining, namely Lok Wah Catholic Primary School, The Little Flower's Catholic Primary School and Catholic Mission School. We are getting encouraging feedbacks from the schools, teachers, students and parents alike.



In order to support the Foundation's on-going program and various new initiatives, we have been very active in fund raising. I expect that 2017 would be another busy year for us. Following our recent Halloween Party at the Ocean Park, we are planning a Bicycle Charity Ride in January, a Charity Mahjong Tournament in February, a Charity Interschool Schools Talent Show and a Charity Arts and Calligraphy Exhibition in March. Please support us by joining some or all of these events.

Indeed, the name of the Foundation is spreading further. This year, the circulation of our newsletter will reach the 8,600 mark. #### **ABOUT US**

Rev. Brother Paul Sun Education Foundation (the 'Foundation') is a charitable trust body approved by the Hong Kong Government as a tax-exempt charitable organisation. The trust document establishing the Foundation sets out the objective, operation, governance and other provisions. The main aim of the Foundation is to promote education, as a continuation of the significant work accomplished by our beloved late Rev. Bro. Paul Sun, founder of St. Joseph's Anglo-Chinese School (SJACS) and St. Joseph's Anglo- Chinese Primary School (SJACPS) Rev. Bro Paul Sun (20 November 1907 – 13 March 1986) lived a life of Catholic faith, hope, and love. He dedicated his life to educating the young. In 1958, with the support of the De La Salle Brothers, the Marist Brothers, and others, he established SJACS and SJACPS in a small old villa, starting with 455 boys. Before returning to The Lord, he learned that his beloved villa would be redeveloped into a modern primary school and a parish church. He won the admiration and respect of his peers. He put SJACS and SJACPS under the special patronage of St. Joseph, and instilled in us, his boys, the St. Joseph Family Spirit.

The Foundation is named in memory and in honour of this great man.

The Robotics Team of SJACS won 1st runner up pin the Hong Kong regional contest of MATE ROV, an international underwater robotics competition organized by the Marine Advanced Technology Education (MATE) Center. They went on to compete in the international final, which was held in the United States from 21 June to 28 June 2016.

The school appealed to the Foundation for support to send the nine-person team to NASA Johnson Space Center's Neutral Buoyancy Lab (NBL) in Houston, Texas for the finals.

We appealed to our donors, many of whom are Josephians themselves. They were proud to see students of their school working hard and doing great things. Many thanks to our generous friends. We collected HK\$55,000 in donations, which were then given to St. Joseph's.


#### Foundation's Charity Mahjong Tournament 2016

Congratulations, Class of '76! We are looking forward to your 45th Reunion party.








#### Foundation's Annual Dinner 2016




